

What Prior Knowledge should students have?

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Keyboard	A device that is used to input text and other commands into a computer.
Mouse	A device that is used to point to and select items on a computer screen.
Save	To store a file or document so that it can be accessed later.
Retrieve	To access a file or document that has been saved.
Text	The words that are used to communicate information.
Data	Facts, figures, and other information that can be processed by a computer.
Software	The non-physical components of a computer, such as the operating system and applications
Hardware	The physical components of a computer, such as the CPU, memory, and storage devices.
